## Welcome to the first Pupil Premium Bulletin!

Welcome to the first Pupil Premium bulletin! Our aim is to let you know who we are and how we manage pupil premium money to help our students improve their skills in Maths, English and Science!

## What is Pupil Premium?

Pupil Premium is additional funding for publicly funded schools in England.

Its main focus is to help disadvantaged pupils of all abilities perform better, and close the gap between them and their peers.

## Who is entitled to Pupil Premium?

- LAC children and some categories of Post-LAC
- FSM Ever 6 (those who have been eligible for free school meals at any point in the last six years)
- Ever 6 services children (i.e. pupils who have parents who have been a member of the armed forces in the past 6 years, or who receive a service pension)

## Bespoke PP Money

All teams have PP money to spend on bespoke interventions for their students. If you have an idea for an effective, measurable intervention talk to your base lead.

## What have we done so far?

Established correct data for the January census

Emma has sent letters to PP parents advising them of her role, and inviting them to discuss with her any barriers they need help with to improve their children's attendance.

Chrissy has discussed requirements with base leads, visiting all bases to identify those students who require interventions the most.

Training has taken place on ARROW and Lexia. Lexia online training is available to staff. Please contact Chrissy if you would like to be involved.

We have identified visitors to schools to inspire and encourage as well as PC/paper based interventions.

Relationships are being nurtured between staff and students to form trust prior to commencing interventions.
