

Rules on Phones, Uniform and Smoking

The Short Stay School for Norfolk has strict rules about the above as we want to ensure that pupils make the best use of their time with us. As a result, we have some rules over which we have a zero tolerance approach.

Mobile Phones

The use of mobile phones in school has been demonstrated to have a significant impact on pupils learning and attainment. It is our policy that **all** pupils hand in their mobile phone upon arrival at school. If a member of staff sees a pupil with a phone they will be instructed to hand it in.



If they refuse, sanctions will be put in place and could result in a fixed term exclusion of one day

School Uniform

The uniform for **all** pupils in the Short Stay School for Norfolk is a white shirt or white collared polo shirt, black trousers or skirt, black footwear, and a black jumper. We do not allow logos on the uniform. Hoodies, jeans and hats are not permitted to be worn in school.

Smoking



At The Short Stay School we do not allow pupils to smoke either on or around the site (i.e by the gates) – this includes the use of e-cigarettes and vapes.

Pupils are not allowed to leave the school site once dropped off unless they have permission to leave at lunchtime.

Once they arrive on site their school day has started (pupils who walk or travel by bus to school can smoke away from the site but must have finished before they approach the gate).

At the end of the day pupils should go directly to their taxi or if they walk or come by bus they should leave the site.

Pupils who are found to be smoking when they should be in school will receive a fixed term exclusion.
